RESOLUTION NUMBER 25-016

WHEREAS, West Pittston Borough Council has been requested to temporarily limit traffic on Boston Avenue from the beginning of the fence located at the Jake Sobeski Stadium to Second Street from 4:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. on October 24, 2025 for the Wyoming Area football game. West Pittston Borough Council has further been requested to limit traffic on Boston Avenue from the beginning of the fence located at the Jake Sobeski Stadium to Second Street from 4:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. on October 31, 2025 for the Wyoming Area football game. Additionally, West Pittston Borough Council has further been requested to prohibit parking on the north side of Boston Avenue from Second Street to the beginning of Jake Sobeski Stadium; and

WHEREAS, West Pittston Borough Council and the Mayor are desirous of granting the requested closing for the benefit of the Wyoming Area football game and our community; and

WHEREAS, such approval is authorized by Section 164-5 of the Code of West Pittston Borough as well as by the Pennsylvania Borough Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the aforesaid requested approval of this special event and the related request for the following is approved and granted:

- Traffic shall be limited to one-way on Boston Avenue from the beginning of the fence located at the Jake Sobeski Stadium to Second Street from 4:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. on October 24, 2025 for the Wyoming Area v. Pittston Area football game.
- Traffic shall be limited to one-way on Boston Avenue from the beginning of the fence located at the Jake Sobeski Stadium to Second Street from 4:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. on October 31, 2025 for the Wyoming Area v. Pittston Area football game.
- Parking is prohibited on the north side of Boston Avenue from Second Street to the beginning of Jake Sobeski Stadium.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that West Pittston Borough shall place such barriers and / or police officers and / or other measures as it sees fit for the public street to be closed.
