Dear Members of Council:

I hope this letter finds you well. As summer rapidly comes to an end, I am writing to you with a request on behalf of Corpus Christi Parish on Luzerne Avenue.

As many of you, if not all, are aware, Bishop Bambera has designated Immaculate Conception Church as the primary worship site for the Parish of Corpus Christi. As a result, many of our principal celebrations will take place at Immaculate Conception Church, welcoming our parishioners from the former Saint Barbara Parish in Exeter. With a limited amount of parking spaces adjacent to the church, it is necessary to plan for additional parking in the community. I write to you at this time to request the Borough Council's permission to utilize the parking lot adjacent to the "Mayor Tony Denisco" building.

The parking lot would be beneficial for our parishioners and would assist with additional parking for our regularly scheduled Masses on Saturday at 5:30pm and Sunday at 10:30am along with special celebrations such as Confirmation which is scheduled for May 2025 and Christmas and Easter Masses, which attract a larger crowd of parishioners from all three of our worship sites.

At this time, I ask that you please consider the use of your parking lot at the "Mayor Tony Denisco" building to assist our parish with additional parking for church celebrations. Please respond in writing when a decision has been made and know that I am available for any further questions or clarification.
