

To all West Pittston residents, please take a moment to read the upcoming recycling changes:

The new recycling program will take effect starting: May 4th, 2022.

Acceptable items to be left out on Wednesday are:

Plastic Bottles

Aluminum Cans

Milk/Juice containers (NOT GLASS)

Paper Egg Cartons

All recyclables must be rinsed out.

Things that will no longer be acceptable are the following:

Garbage - Food Waste - Food tainted items (pizza boxes, containers, paper plates/napkins) - Paper Towels - Plastic Bags - Styrofoam of ANY kind - PVC piping - Wood - Propane/Helium Tanks - Batteries - Toys - Plastic Strapping - Ropes/Cords - Scrap Metal - Rubber Hoses - Tarps - Plastic Sheets - Glass - Any Used Plastic Cutlery, Straws, plates, etc. - Ceramic Products - Swimming Pool Products (including empty chemical containers)

(Page One - Turn Over)

All cardboard products must be taken to the DPW recycling facility at 505 Delaware Avenue from 8am to 12pm every first and third Saturday of the month.

Cardboard products include: Newspaper, junk mail, magazines, books, and cereal boxes.

You cannot recycle any of the following household garbage: Pots, pans, electronics, anything with an electrical cord, small appliances, plastic storage containers, etc.

Please rinse out your recycling containers if using them for both yard waste and recycling. If you need additional containers, they may be requested by contacting DPW.
